



Virtual Walkrounds

With the budget pressures on training to minimise the 'On the Job' practical elements, innovative ways have to be considered to reduce costs or enhance the training available. Virtual environments allow a student to explore a future workplace and rehearse their reactions to instructor induced incidents.

Previous Experience:

- Virtual environment of the external views of an aircraft to enable the student to walk through the pre-flight inspection and checks associated with a number of aircraft types.
- Internal views of an aircraft to allow students to rehearse regular internal inspections of loads and passengers during flight.
- Internal views of a submarine to enable pre-deployment familiarisation training to identify escape routes and safety equipment.
- Internal views of historic naval ship to ensure the internal layout is captured for prosperity.

Deployed in either animation or free play formats with joystick controls these trainers can be developed using photographs, CATIA models or within a gaming environment. Whichever methods is used, the student is exposed to the conditions and, where required, emergencies associated with their future workplace.
