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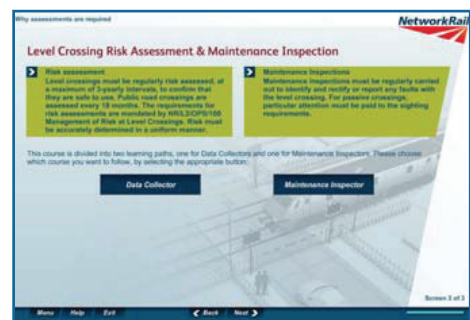
Network Rail - Level Crossing DVD

Network Rail engaged Pennant to research, design and create a distance learning package for Assessors and Inspector/Maintainers of Level Crossings across the rail network.

The courseware was to be structured to provide two distinct learning paths. The first path for the Assessor and the other for the Inspector. In the interest of cost efficiency they need to utilize many of the graphical resources across both learning paths, with text and technical detail bespoke to suit the application.

Pennant delivered a graphics-rich, interactive solution, which includes many high fidelity emulated exercises allowing the user to explore life-like scenarios in the safe environment of the courseware. This approach is known to provide a high level of user engagement, consequently promoting a deeper understanding of the subject and high levels of post-learning retention.

The content was structured to cover the Assessment of a variety of crossings in a wide range of locations and situations. All aspects of Assessment are covered when explaining risk potential, including crossing user and train driver sighting, approach topography, line and road curvature, weather conditions, fluctuations in traffic flow etc.



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
